



Although the people assembled virtually here this morning are in various locations, Westminster Presbyterian Church is located in the watershed of the lower Hudson River. We acknowledge that the watershed where we reside is the fundamental ecological grounding for concern about Creation.

The Mahican people were forcibly removed from their homelands in the Hudson and Housatonic River Valleys but still exist today as the Stockbridge-Munsee Community, a federally-recognized Tribal Nation headquartered in Wisconsin. We honor and respect the many diverse indigenous peoples still connected to this land on which we gather. We are grateful to those who lived here before us. We carry responsibility for those who will live here in the future.




