Join Churches for Middle East Peace (CMEP) to host a conversation about peacebuilding and advocacy related to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. Speakers include members of CMEP staff and peace-builders from the Middle East. See the speakers page for more info.

This year, our presentations will give particular attention to the events that have unfolded in the Holy Land since October 7, 2023. Following October 7th, CMEP has continuously called for a permanent bilateral ceasefire, the allowance of humanitarian aid into Gaza, and for the release of all hostages. We recognize that current events are rapidly changing, and our speakers will be prepared to discuss the most current news and updates from the ground. During our presentations, we will discuss the importance of advocating for human rights in Israel and the Palestinian territories. The occupation has impacts on people living on all sides of the conflict including both Israelis and Palestinians. Understanding the geopolitics, social considerations, and other aspects of the conflict demands that we look beyond the headlines into the daily realities of people living on the ground. Churches for Middle East Peace is pro-Israeli, pro-Palestinian, pro-peace, and pro-justice. The things we learn working for peace in in the Middle East can be applied to conflicts in all areas of our lives; including conflicts with our families, friends, neighbors, and communities. Join us to learn what it means to be someone who pursues peace, while also advocating for justice in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and beyond.

Formed in 1984, Churches for Middle East Peace (CMEP) is a coalition of national Church denominations and organizations working to encourage U.S. policies that actively promote just, lasting and comprehensive resolutions to conflicts in the Middle East. CMEP helps church organizations, leaders, and individuals nationwide advocate in a knowledgeable, timely, holistic, and effective way to express their concerns about justice and peace for all peoples in the Middle East.

Guided by deep faith, religious commitments, and humanitarian principles, we are committed to peace and justice for all people, including Palestinians and Israelis. We care deeply for people who are marginalized and living in poverty. We take seriously their protection in times of conflict. Our message emphasizes compassion while upholding justice in pursuit of security, freedom, and dignity for all the people of the Holy Land.

WE SUPPORT THE PEACEBUILDING AND ADVOCACY WORK OF ISRAELI AND PALESTINIANS COMMITTED TO CONSTRUCTIVE CONFLICT & BUILDING BRIDGES ACROSS DIVIDES. We work to promote peace and reconciliation between all people of the land. We believe in supporting Jews, Muslims, and Christians, as they courageously pursue a radical calling toward both justice and peace.

WE ADVOCATE ON ISSUES RELATED TO HOLISTIC PEACEBUILDING, MEETING HUMANITARIAN NEEDS, AND HUMAN RIGHTS IN ISRAEL, THE OCCUPIED PALESTINIAN TERRITORIES, AND THE BROADER MIDDLE EAST. INVITE


