- **Creating a safe environment:** Maintaining a safe environment for children in accordance with WPC's [Safe Church Policy](#) norms and practices.
- **Building relationships with children and families:** Getting to know children, sharing their concerns, needs, and joys, and maintaining a good relationship with families.
